RE: Discontinuation of old book of business reporting system for non-commercial automobile liability insurance

Pursuant to K.S.A. 40-2,241 – 40-2,250 and K.S.A. 8-173, the Kansas Department of Insurance (KDOI) has the authority to create an online insurance verification system for the verification of evidence of motor vehicle liability insurance.

The Kansas Insurance Verification System (KSIVS) has been successfully implemented and is nearing the July 1 effective date of the new online insurance verification system. Per the statute, the KSIVS is to be the sole method used to report the insurance information to the state.

Insurance companies providing automobile liability coverage to vehicles registered in Kansas shall meet the reporting requirements as specified in the KSIVS Implementation Guide for Insurance Companies.

As of the date of this notice, all insurance company reporting is to be done through the Kansas Insurance Verification System (KSIVS).

The current reporting to the Kansas Department of Revenue's EDI system is discontinued and will no longer be accepting submissions.
